

WHEN YOU SIGN UP TO BRING SNACKS FOR 1ST, 3RD, OR 5TH SUNDAY...

... YOU ARE SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY'S "SOCIAL HOUR" FOLLOWING THE SERVICE, AND YOU ARE COMMITTING TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING TASKS. **THANK YOU!**

REMEMBER THE DATE FOR WHICH YOU SIGN UP! (Take a reminder card, if it will help.)

NOTE: If you cannot fulfill your commitment, you could try to "recruit" someone else from the Congregation to bring snacks on that date.

BRING

- *Light* snacks for about 40 people & any serving tools, e.g., knives, you'll need.

TIP: Home-made treats are great, but not required or expected.

ARRIVE around 10:30 a.m.

NOTE: You may have to wait for set-up person with the key to open Lodge.

BEFORE SERVICE BEGINS at 11 a.m.

- Set out on counter between kitchen and meeting hall all food that does not require refrigeration.
- If you did not bring paper plates/napkins, get what you need from bin on top of UCoT supply cabinet in coat room.

NOTE: You'll be coordinating kitchen activities with a Coffee Committee person, who is responsible for bringing cream, making coffee, washing cups, putting away supplies, and making sure someone washes the dirty towels.

JUST BEFORE SERVICE ENDS AT NOON

- Quietly go to the kitchen & set out refrigerated food or do any other last minute prep.

NO LATER THAN 12:30

- Begin to clear up food counter - disposing of trash in designated can, removing leftovers, wiping down the counter and food prep areas.

NOTE: Any help you can give the Coffee Committee with collecting & washing dirty cups would be greatly appreciated and expedite closing the building.

WHEN YOU SIGN UP TO BRING FLOWERS FOR 1ST, 3RD, OR 5TH SUNDAY...

... YOU ARE HELPING TO CREATE A SACRED SPACE & WELCOMING ENVIRONMENT FOR THE SERVICE. YOU ARE ALSO COMMITTING TO THE TASKS BELOW. **THANK YOU!**

REMEMBER THE DATE for which you sign up! (Take a reminder card by the sign-up list, if it will help.) If you cannot fulfill your commitment, try to "recruit" someone else from the Congregation to bring flowers in your place on that date.

BRING FLOWERS *arranged in a vase* (or an attractive potted plant) of appropriate size for the table beside the pulpit.

TAKE VASE AND FLOWERS AWAY with you (or arrange for someone else to take them) after the service.
