



UCOT Covid Policy

Although we strongly recommend that our attendees be vaccinated against Covid, we will not require proof of vaccination / boosters for our attendees.

When Munro is preaching, masks will be required since his wife is immune-compromised. We will have a supply of masks available for those who did not bring one.

People in the same household may sit together, but others will be socially distanced.

If the CovidActNow website (https://covidactnow.org/us/new_mexico-nm/county/taos_county/) shows Taos County as green, no further restrictions are required. If our status is anything else, then:

- Masks will be required at both services and circles.
- Coffee and snacks will not be provided at services.
- There will be no singing of hymns at services.
